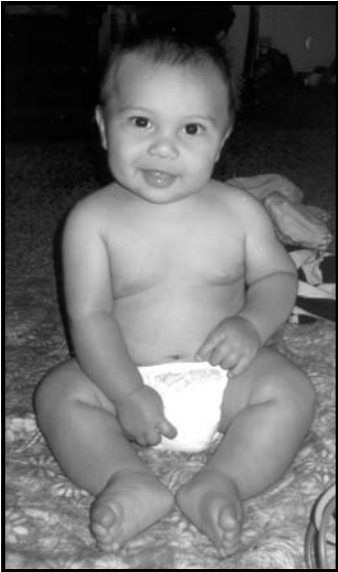

and gutters as needed. Wood shingles are especially fire-prone. Consider replacing single roofs with a noncombustible material, being sure to comply with zoning regulations.

*Step Six: Maintain the defensible space. Each year, before fire season, re-evaluate the area surrounding a home, re-establish the distance between fuels, clean up and haul off debris, and keep the roof clean.

The www.firewise.org. Website features an interactive module providing questions on how to prepare a home for the wildfire season. The module and other tips are under the category "Firewise You Can Use," then look for "Preparing a Home for Wildfire Season."

Firewise is a cooperative effort of federal, state, local

and private agencies and organizations to promote fire safety in the wildland urban interface. The primary Firewise principle is that such
