Shadow Creek ready to entertain

Cable television service may no longer be available to Cave Junction residents, but that doesn't mean that first-class entertainment is any harder to obtain.

Wild Blue starts at \$49.99 per month, with high-speed Internet available in rural areas. DirecTV starts at \$34.99 per month with more than 150 channels.

"The price will always be less, because

cable is a middleman," Campbell said. "We can get them the best possible promotion."

There are plenty of specials available to Shadow Creek customers. Dish Network is offering a \$25 credit off any package for six months and 15 free movie channels for three months, including HBO. DirecTV is offering \$21 off packages for one year.

Digital Video Recorder (DVR) is also available through Shadow Creek, and carries up to 500 hours of programming.

"DVR enables you to watch what you want to watch when you want to watch it," Campbell said.

Shadow Creek does all its own installations, which are free for basic customers. It also provides bundling for its customers with Qwest and Frontier for Internet and telephone services.

Savage Rapids Dam removal under way

The two primary coffer dams essential to removal of Savage Rapids Dam on Rogue River near Grants Pass were to be completed by Monday, April 27, the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) announced last week.

The coffer dams will allow the contractor, Slayden Construction Group, of Stayton, Ore., to slowly close the radial gates and raise the water surface behind Savage Rapids Dam to restore fish passage through the dam's south fish ladder.

Downstream flows will be reduced some while water is stored behind the dam.

A dry working environment within the coffer dams will allow crews to begin demolishing the right side of Savage Rapids Dam.

The new Savage Rapids pumping plant is ready to begin operations at the start of the Grants Pass Irrigation District's (GPID) 2009 irrigation season. Congress authorized BOR to construct the Savage Rapids pumping plant to supply water to the district.

Motorists are advised to be aware of heavy equipment entering and exiting Foothill Boulevard in the area adjacent to the construction site and to be cautious of congestion and pedestrian traffic on Hwy. 99 near the dam.

Plans call for removing the coffer dams and diverting the river through the breached section of the dam by October. Removal of two addi-

tional bays and other remaining construction should be completed by mid-December.

The total estimated project cost is \$39.3 million, with \$3 million for dam removal provided by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board.

GPID constructed Savage Rapids Dam in 1921 to divert water for irrigation. An amended 2001 federal court consent decree required the district to cease using the dam for water diversions by the end of the 2008 irrigation season. Congress subsequently authorized BOR to construct a new pumping plant to supply water to the district.

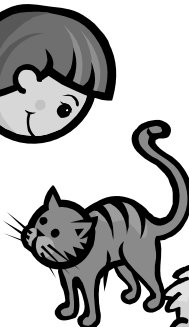
