Pitney Bowes screens, packages and ships the cards at no charge, and contributes thousands of volunteer hours at sites around the country.
For reasons of processing and safety, participants are asked to refrain from sending "care packages," monetary gifts, using glitter or including any inserts with the cards.
This is the fourth year that the Red Cross and Pitney Bowes have held the Holiday Mail for Heroes program. More than three million cards have been distributed during the first three years of the campaign.

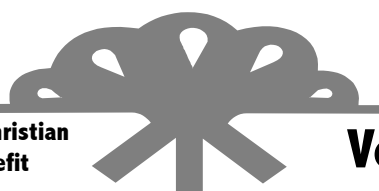

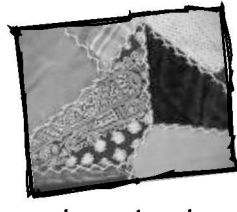
