

Tales from the Police Blotter

Thursday, Feb. 24
* There’ s nothing worse than a woman scorned, as in the woman on Reeves Creek Road who wants her ex to get in trouble for cheating on her with a 17-year-old girl in Washington state.

Friday, Feb. 25
* Little Richards Trucking reported \$1,000 worth of liquid fertilizer was taken from a flatbed trailer parked overnight in the Junction Inn parking lot. The driver followed tracks in the snow and found packing materials on the other side of the fence, but there was no suspect information.
* A man in the 1000 block of Rockydale Road said someone threatened to bring 12 people to strong-arm him into giving up medical marijuana that was allegedly owed.
