

Tales from the Police Blotter

Friday, March 18

* Concerned for children at a nearby bus stop, a woman called law enforcement regarding a homeless man in a maroon coat with a turquoise-colored guitar who was sleeping on a porch in Kerby.

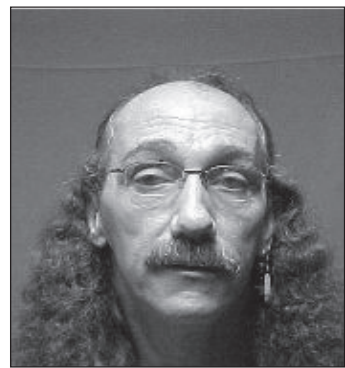

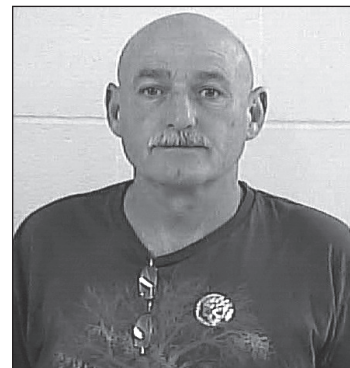
