Q. My wife recently passed away and my 11 year old grandson is having a terrible time understanding why she died. I don't want to take him to a therapist because he doesn't seem to be 'sick'. What does Good Grief offer and how can it benefit my grandson?

A. 'Good Grief' is the name for a family based support program to help children ages 5 through 18 learn how to cope with the loss of someone they love. They have the chance to meet children their age going through the same experiences and learn how to develop coping skills that fit their own character. They do this with the help of staff and trained volunteers who guide them through informative activities related to grieving.

Each session parents also learn new ways to support themselves and their children through participation in some of the activities and during their separate parent meeting time.

Q. How much does it cost?

**NOTICE OF PETITION TO ADMINISTER ESTATE OF ELAINE IRENE EDWARDS**  
Superior Court of the State of California, County of Lake, Case No. PR501304

To all heirs, beneficiaries, creditors, contingent creditors, and persons who may otherwise be interested in the will or estate, or both, of ELAINE IRENE EDWARDS aka ELAINE IRENE BRACKEN. A PETITION FOR PROBATE has been filed by David T. Bracken in the Superior Court of California, County of LAKE. THE PETITION FOR PROBATE requests that David T. Bracken be appointed as personal representative to administer the estate of the decedent. THE PETITION requests the decedent's will and codicils, if any, be admitted to probate. The will and any codicils are available for examination in the file kept by the court. THE PETITION requests authority to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (This authority will allow the personal representative to take many actions without obtaining court approval. Before taking certain very important actions, however, the personal representative will be required to give notice to interested persons unless they have waived notice or consented to the proposed action.) The independent administration authority will be granted unless an interested person files an objection to the petition and shows good cause why the court should not grant the authority. A HEARING on the petition will be held on April 14, 2011 at 3:00 PM in Dept. No. 1 located at Superior Court of the State of California, County of Lake, 255 N. Forbes Street, 4th Floor, Lakeport, CA 95453. IF YOU OBJECT to the granting of the petition, you should appear at the hearing and state your objections or file written objections with the court before the hearing. Your appearance may be in person or by your attorney. IF YOU ARE A CREDITOR or a contingent creditor of the deceased, you must file your claim with the court and mail a copy to the personal representative appointed by the court within four months from the date of first issuance of letters as provided in California Probate Code section 9100. The time for filing claims will not expire before four months from the hearing date noticed above. YOU MAY EXAMINE the file kept by the court. If you are a person interested in the estate, you may file with the court a Request for Special Notice (form DE-154) of the filing of an inventory and appraisal of estate assets or of any petition or account as provided in Probate Code section 1250. A Request for Special Notice form is available from the court clerk.
