

In response to the question of whether OSP has been forced to increase their patrol numbers as a result of county cut-backs, Collins stated, "The Central Point Area Command has re-allocated certain resources from Central Point to Grants Pass based strictly on officer safety issues resulting from some of the types of calls that troopers are responding to, and the inherent danger associated with those calls. However, this has not increased our resources or numbers, it has simply caused us to re-adjust them

The Oregon State Police Central Point Area Command serves citizens throughout Jackson and Josephine counties; although these troopers are a statewide resource and may be deployed anywhere in Oregon

"I think it's really unfortunate, that as a society, we place an emphasis on profit over safety and accountability," said Dr. Jim Nordal, of Cave Junction Family Medicine. "It's a huge problem that if science disagrees with politics, it gets buried. Most of our politicians are lawyers, and for lawyers, it's all about the sphere of opinion. With science, it's about the
