"My Mother has been a model for my sisters and I," said Katrina Davis, who currently volunteers with the Oakland Valley Fire Department. "We grew up knowing this is something we do for each other. It never occurred to us to question if we had time for it."

Davis's other daughters, Lynsta Davis Bemis, was a scout leader for many years and also taught medical classes for volunteer firefighters; and Trinalyn Davis Wilson led the IVHS and Rogue River High School Equestrian Teams for many

years, and currently volunteers at a horse rescue operation in Eureka, CA. And the tradition has passed down to the next generation; the Davis grandchildren also volunteer. "They never complain, it is just something we all do," Davis said.

"I don't seek attention, but if telling my story inspires others to volunteer, then it's worth it," Davis said. "There's a lot of people around here who help others out. When we lift people up, sometimes we're successful and sometimes not, but we must keep trying. That's what it's all

about."

Davis invites others to get involved with the schools, noting that there's more students, less money and more requirements. She encourages potential volunteers to talk to school officials to discern how they can plug in.

"It's very rewarding to help them learn and develop into the people they are now," Davis said. "So many people come up to me and say hello, it's really joyous."

IVHS Track complete

When school let out on Wednesday, June 11th the Illinois Valley High School community had a new track. The Rotary clubs of Josephine County coupled with the Illinois Valley Booster Club and the final funding from the Josephine County Educational Fund, Inc. completed the project that began as a "field of dreams" five years ago.

Through the hard work of the Rotary and Booster Club, it became a reality. This past month the all-weather surface was laid and the track was striped and ready for competition.

The athletes at the school will no longer need to set up and tear down the pole vault pits, as they were installed as well.

The six lane track created quite a "buzz" at the high school and in the community during the unveiling at Illinois Valley's graduation on June 4th.

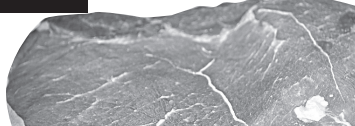
