Lions Club readies for Labor Day Festival

The Talent Show is open to amateurs of all ages and scheduled for all three days of the Festival. Juniors will perform on Saturday, Intermediates on Sunday and Adults on Monday. All those wishing to participate must sign up by August 27. Karaoke will also be held all three days of the Festival and is open to all ages. This event is not a contest, but a fun thing to do for both performers and all watchers.
