Become a Senior Companion volunteer

Senior Companions are volunteers age 55 and over with qualifying incomes who make a difference by providing assistance and friendship to adults who have difficulty with daily living tasks, such as shopping or paying bills. As a Senior Companion, you help these adults remain independent in their homes so they don't have to move to more costly institutional care. You give families much needed time off from their care giving duties, and provide a peace of mind to families when they are absent from their loved ones. Senior Companions serve 15 to 40 hours per week helping an average of four to six adults live independently in their own homes. Volunteers receive a comprehensive orientation, training from the organization where they serve, supplemental insurance while on duty, and a tax-free hourly stipend. And remember: When you volunteer, you're not just helping others—you're helping yourself. Volunteering leads to new discoveries and new friends.
