"There is a lot more to opening a city Facebook page than you would think," Councilor Gillette said. "Anything that we put on the page would have to be official. This is not an informal Facebook page." In order to follow public meeting laws, city staff and councilors will not be allowed to use social media to publicly discuss city business. City councilors and staff will only use the city's Facebook page to inform people about city activities, promote city sponsored events and meetings, and provide information during emergencies. All links on the Facebook page will lead back to the official city website.

It was then brought to the attention of the council that a number of addresses within city limits had been incorrectly assigned. The problem was brought to the attention of city staff by emergency services personnel. There is currently a discrepancy between the addresses as assigned by the city and the addresses as they appear in the GIS mapping software used by emergency services. This can lead to paramedics or firefighters showing up at the wrong address, which results in delayed emergency aid. The council instructed city staff to identify the improperly assigned addresses and to notify residents as soon as possible.

The Cave Junction City Council meets the second Monday of each month, with additional meetings as needed. Meetings are held at 7 p.m. at City Hall, 222 W. Lister Street. The public is always welcome.
