### Who did the witch really see?

King Saul was at his wit's end and trembling with fear. The entire Philistine army had gathered to attack Israel's smaller and weaker troops. Saul moaned, "If only Samuel were here, he would tell me what to do." But the prophet had died a few years earlier.

Saul had persistently refused to listen to the Lord, and now in his distress God would not answer him.

God had commanded His people never to consult a witch or medium (*Lev. 19:31 & 20:27*) Now Saul had little regard for God's instruction. "Then Saul said to his servants, seek me a woman that has a familiar spirit that I may inquire of her." Finding a woman of Endor who claimed to consult the dead, the king disguised himself and went to see her. He said to the medium "bring me up Samuel." After using her spells and enchant-

ments an apparition claiming to be Samuel the prophet appeared and gave Saul a hopeless message that he and his sons would die in battle the next day. (*1 Samuel 31:2-4*) Who spoke to Saul through the witch – was it really a prophet of God?

Do dead people come back to converse with the living? *Eccl. 9:5,6* says, "For the living know they shall die: but the dead know nothing."

How did God make man in the beginning? *Genesis 2:7* "The Lord formed man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul."

So what happens when we die? *Eccl. 12:7* "then shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the spirit shall return to God who gave it." Breath and Spirit are interchangeable. Notice what *Job 27:2* says, All the while my breath is in me, and the spirit

of God was in my nostrils."

So where do the dead go when they die? *Job 21:32* says, "Yet shall he be brought to the grave, and shall remain in the tomb." Jesus addressed this issue in *John 5:28, 29* "all that are in the graves shall hear His voice, and come forth; they that have done good to the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil to the resurrection of damnation."

Are saved people in heaven? How about good king David? *Acts 2:34* "For David is not ascended into the heavens." Also check out *Acts 2:29*.

Does the soul die when the body dies? *Ezekiel 18:4* "the soul that sins, it shall die." Who alone is immortal now? Check out *1 Tim. 6:15,16*

When will the righteous be given immortality (eternal life). Look at *1 Corin. 15:51-53*

Since witches and psychics can't con-

tact the dead, who are they contacting? *Rev. 16:14* "They are the spirits of devils, working miracles."

How effective will Satan's evil angels be in the last days? *Rev. 18:23* "by your sorceries were all nations deceived." See *Rev. 12:9*

Are people still trying to contact their dead loved ones? *1 Tim 4:1* "In the last times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils."

So who did the witch really see? It was none other than a demon disguised as prophet Samuel!

How does God regard this kind of activity? See *Rev. 21:8*
