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## Monday, Nov. 27

The home owner at that site allowed a search of his property, but the trailer was not found. The resident claimed that he had been getting numerous reports regarding stolen property, particularly motorcycles. He has an open case with Jackson County to determine who is slandering him and posting false claims on the website.

\*A gal in the 200 block of Logan Cut Drive took a book without permission from the Grants Pass Bureau of Land Management Office on October 31. The incident was on video, so a charge of third-degree theft will be referred to the District Attorney's office. (Get a Kindle.)

\*A fellow living in Canyonville bought a house in the 7000 block of Takilma Road. He hired someone to stay at the new residence for a couple of weeks, until he could move. He was involved in a disturbance on the freeway, and now the fellow has a no-contact order against him. The people he hired are refusing to leave his newly purchased house, and he claimed they

took a U-Haul truck with his Romanian SKS 7.62x .39 rifle, Remington pellet rifle, washer, dryer, refrigerator, chest freezer, fire safe with titles, and a 43-inch TV from Costco.

\*A chap in the 100 block of Cowboy Way will consider obtaining a stalking order against the revolutionary in the 400 block of Queen of Bronze Road that keeps shooting his black powder cannon.

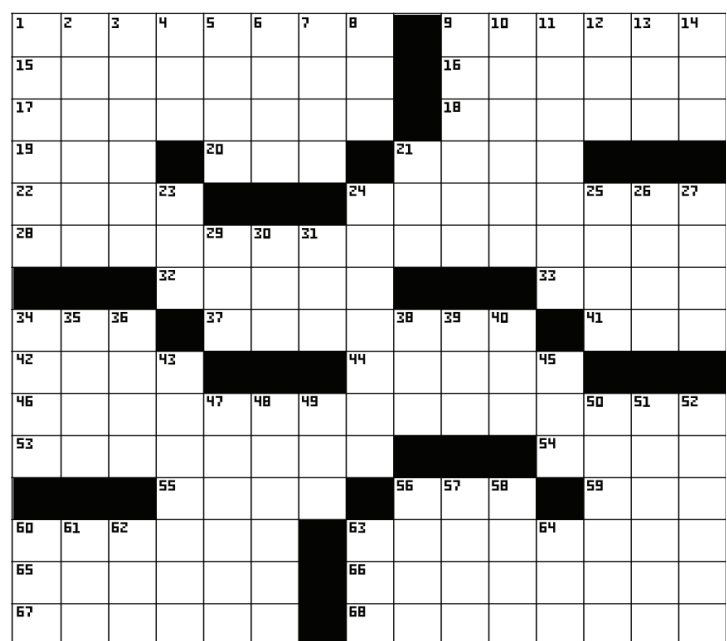
