

Augustino Estate & Vineyard set to host Healing Hearts and Hooves fundraiser

The Healing Hearts and Hooves fourth annual dinner and auction is set for July 21. This fundraiser will be held at the Augustino Estate during the hours of 5-9 p.m. The food is catered by Casa Amiga with music by Gary Margason.

This event is a definite must! Renee Herndon explained why: “The money that they raise by our dinner and auction fundraiser all goes to the Healing Hearts and Hooves program. We will have a part of the auction that will go specifically to sponsoring students, so it will be kind of like a scholarship to pay for the lessons. Last year we were able to cover all of the lessons for the rest of the year by our auction. It also goes to insurance. We have to have insurance for the program; that’s very expensive. It goes to equipment, it goes to games and stuff that the students can play and just buying things that the program needs to have class.” The Healing Hearts and Hooves program has several students. “We generally have like 12 to 15 per year and we do classes June through October,” Herndon said.

This fundraiser has also changed over

the years. “Our program has been around since 2009. We used to do online options as our fundraisers. Then four years ago we decided to step it up and do an actual community event. That’s what our summer fundraiser is, this dinner and auction at the local winery: Augustino.”

Herndon elaborated on the upcoming auction: “We have a silent auction and a live auction. There are several different items, some are horse items, some are not, so we do have people come that aren’t necessarily horse people. We have items like gift certificates for overnight to a couple hotels on the beach; we’ve gotten tickets to Oregon State University football games, tickets to the Oregon Zoo, Oregon Shakespeare, local gift certificates like Backstreet Salon and Reflection Salon and a lot of other things.”

To participate in this unique opportunity, tickets can be purchased for \$25 per person. Herndon explained, “I would prefer that people purchase them ahead of time, but they can be bought at the door or they can be bought at First Community Credit Union in Cave Junction.
