Attention quilt and art lovers

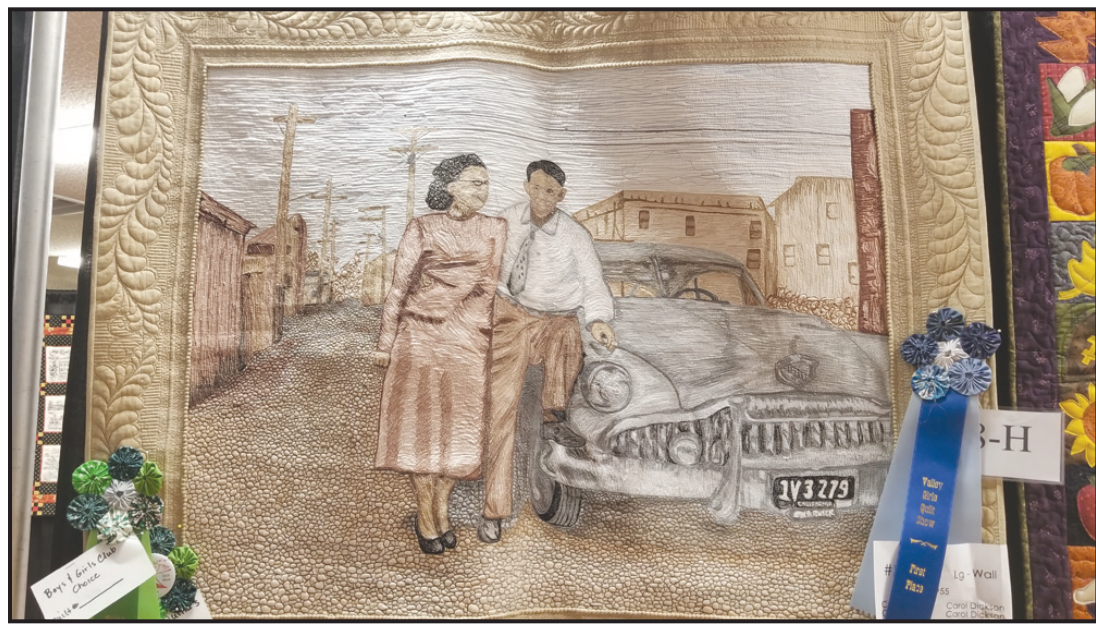

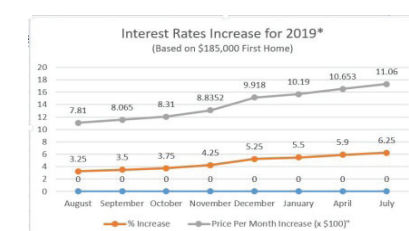
