

# Tales from the Rural Patrol

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**Monday, Oct. 29**

\*Several items were reportedly stolen Oct. 24 from the 500 block of Arrowhead Drive. The thieves helped themselves to an ice chest, gas can, Craftsman chain saw, walkie talkie, flashlights, padlocks, an antique .22 pellet pistol, a U.S. Marine knife, camping knife, compass, and three car batteries. Photos of a white vehicle with a black hood were provided to Josephine County Sheriff’s Office (JCSO).

\*Robert Martin threatened an individual and filled an answering machine with demands for money to buy marijuana. Martin, 48, was arrested at 11:25 a.m. in the 2600 block of Hamilton Lane for restraining order violation and was detained in Josephine County Jail.

\*Between Oct. 22-26, a 4,000-pound Gray air bumper jack was lifted from the 100 block of Krauss Lane.

\*Melissa Lowenstein, 52, was arrested at 12:05 p.m. and detained in JoCo Jail. for trespassing in the 24300 block of Redwood Hwy.

misdeemeanor warrant from JCSO for failure to appear for second-degree theft.

\*A fugitive with felony warrants from JCSO, Ashland Police Department, and Grants Pass Department of Public Safety was apprehended near W. River Street and N. Redwood Hwy. at 1:28 p.m. Janique Lee Koset, 28, was detained in JoCo Jail. Her charges include failure to appear for first-degree burglary, two counts of first-degree theft, unauthorized use of a vehicle

(UUV), attempt to commit Class C Felony (assault on an officer), and resisting arrest.

\*Car thieves weren’t being picky when they stole a 1993 Toyota 4Runner overnight from the 23700 block of Redwood Hwy. The registered owner claimed that the Toyota was dead, and whoever stole it would have had to tow it.

**Wednesday, Oct. 31**

\*Several items were stolen from a 2000 Chevy Tahoe that was parked at a repair shop on S. Redwood Hwy. between July 30-Oct. 26. Two Visologic headrest TV monitors, an RF audio transmitter, a DVD player, seven DVDs, and an air compressor mysteriously disappeared.
