## Sunday, June 11

\*Driving 105 in a 55-zone was much too fast, so that motorist near Draper Valley Road and Redwood Hwy. was cited at 10:55 a.m. The appearance date at Josephine County Circuit Court (JCCC) was set for July 14.

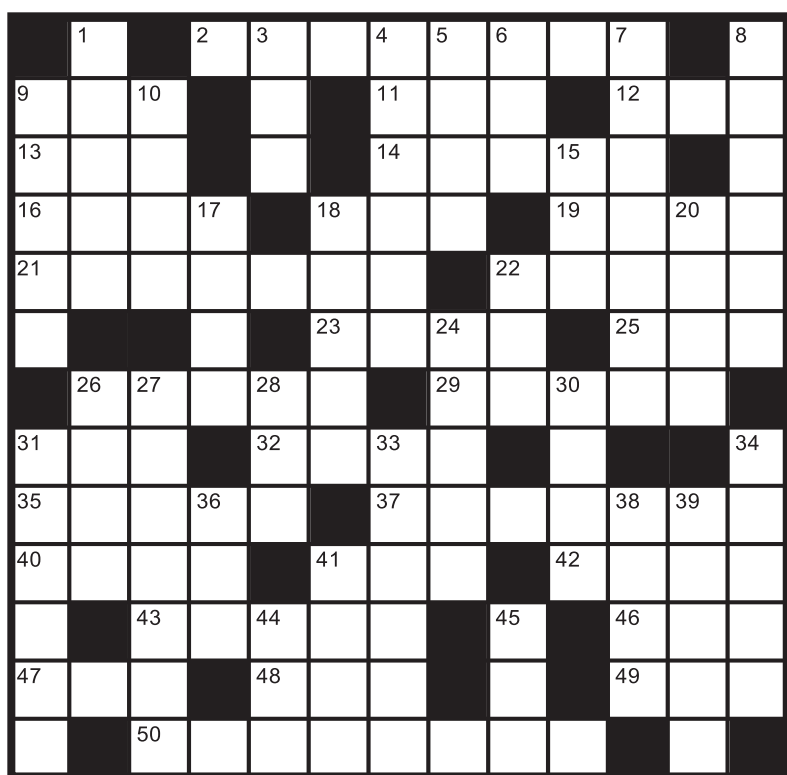

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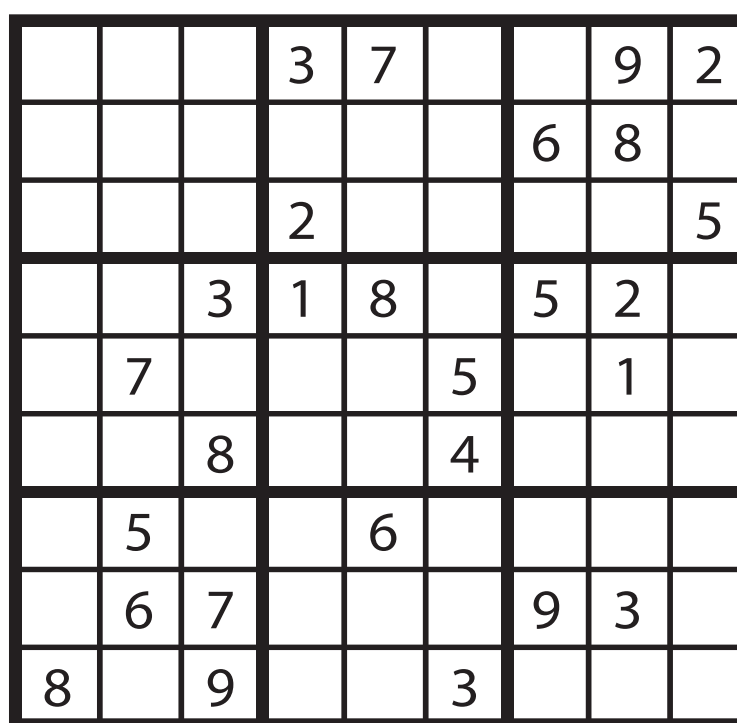
