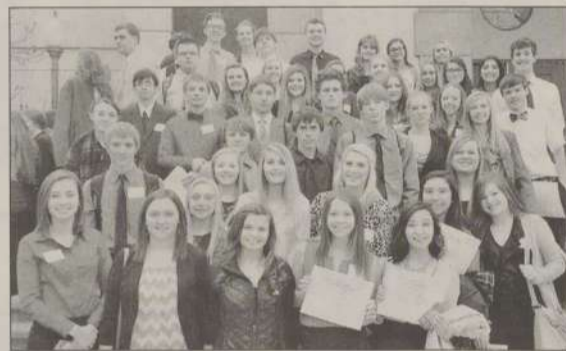
In observing National Scout Month, troop 444 sponsored by Methodist Men's Club, will be honored at local church.
