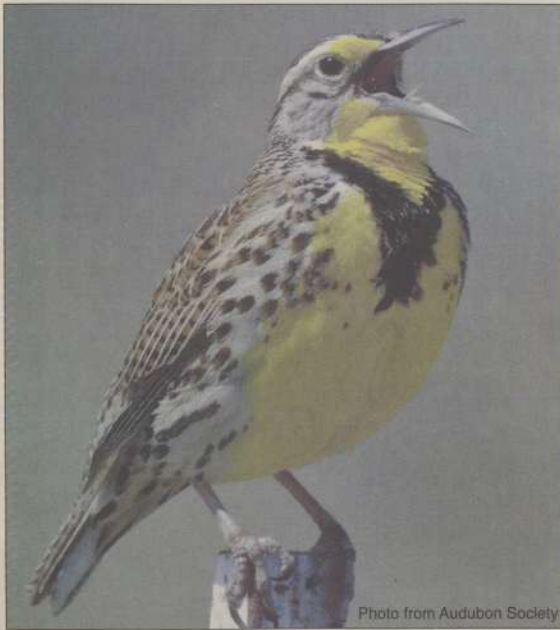

June 21, 1805. "There is also a species of Lark, much resembling the Old Field Lark, with a yellow breast and a black spot on the croup. The beak is somewhat larger and more curved, and the notes differ considerably."
