Baker County Cattlewomen and Cattlemen Join Forces with Shriners to Benefit Children

This information was taken from the Baker County Cattlewomen's promotional brochure designed and printed by the Record-Courier.

Since 1973, the Shriners and the Baker County Cattlewomen and Cattlemen have joined forces to provide an opportunity for people from across the state and from differing backgrounds to share in a common cause - raising awareness and raising funds for children. Combining the efforts of livestock producers, 4-H and FFA youth, local businesses and the Shriners themselves, this fundraiser has increased in popularity to become possibly one of the most talked about successes in both state and national Shrine organizations.

Shrine Steer History

Donated to the Shriners by the Baker County Cattlewomen and Cattlemen, the Shrine Steer has a unique story. Cattlemen member and Shiner Rod McCullough is credited with the original suggestion of a fundraiser with local flair: in 1973, the first Shrine Steer was purchased at the Baker County Junior Show Auction and donated directly to the Shriners Hospital in the form of beef for its patients.

After its procurement in 1975, the steer was donated to the Shriners to be resold at auction at the East West Shrine Game with proceeds to benefit the hospitals. The results of that first auction were so successful that today it has become the featured attraction of the halftime festivities, and the tradition of the Shrine Steer is firmly established as almost synonymous locally with the Game itself. The 2015 Shrine Steer belongs to Cody Belveal and will be auctioned multiple times to raise as much money as possible for the Shriners Childrens Hospital in Portland.
