

Pine-Eagle FFA Competed in State FFA Career Development

Last week nine members of the Pine-Eagle FFA traveled to Corvallis to compete in the 2016 State FFA Career Development Events hosted by Oregon State University. Events held included Ag Mechanics, Meats, Dairy Foods, Livestock Judging, Horse Judging, Dairy Cattle Judging, Crops/Agronomy, Ag Communications, Food Science, and Poultry. The activities were held on May 2nd and 3rd at various locations on Oregon State University and Central High School campuses, as well as the Linn County Fair Grounds/Expo Center. Pine-Eagle members competed in the Ag Mechanics and Crops/Agronomy events.

Moroni Jensen, Shane Denig, JW Chetwood and Brandon Roe tested their skills in Ag Mechanics hosted at Central High School Ag Department. Each member on the team competed in all of the following areas: arc welding, surveying, electrical wiring, electrical motors, ag power equipment, baler part identification, and a written test. In arc welding members performed a variety of welds including edge, lap, and t-fillet in the flat, horizontal, and vertical positions. In electrical wiring members wired up a male electrical cord end, two three way switches, and an outlet, utilizing typical household plastic electrical boxes and romex. Members took a small test on reading and interpreting the ID plate on an electrical motor, how they work, and part ID. Power equipment found members identifying parts on a 130 hp Massey Ferguson tractor and Hesston baler. The contest also tested members' general ag mechanics knowledge on a 50 question test. The Pine-Eagle team placed 5th in the State. Individual accomplishments include Moroni placing 9th high individual. In welding Shane Denig placed 2nd high. The Pine-Eagle Ag Mechanics team would like to thank James Chetwood for donating his time to assist in welding instruction and practices.

Colton Walker, Joseph Aguilar, Brandon Roe, Darby Shouse, Abby Graven, and Kylee Jensen showed off their crops knowledge in the Crop/Agronomy CDE hosted at OSU. These members took a general crops written test with questions ranging from soils, fertilizers, plant anatomy, plant processes, and crop production in Oregon. Members then moved on to identify crops and weeds by live samples, pressed samples, and seeds. They evaluated and placed 4 samples of each of the following hay, silage, fruit, and nuts. They also evaluated samples of crops seed, identifying the main crop seed and identifying any other crop or weed seeds that existed in the sample. The Pine-Eagle team placed 5th.
