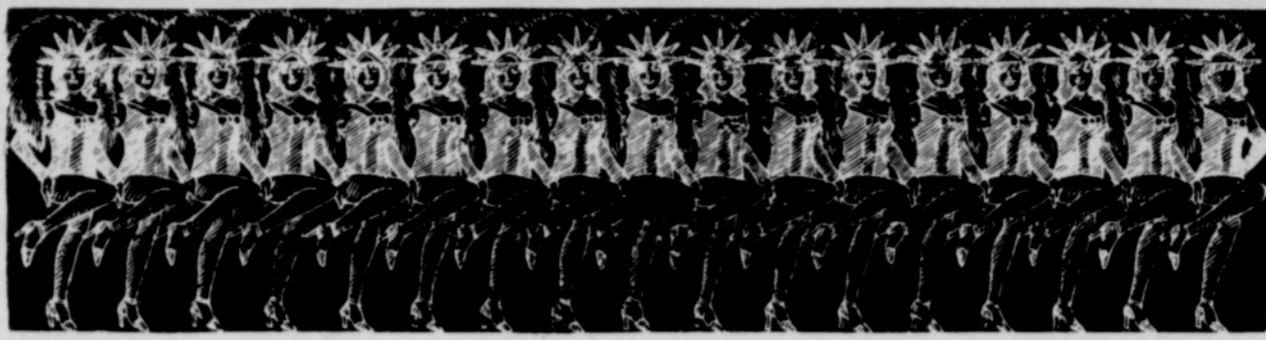
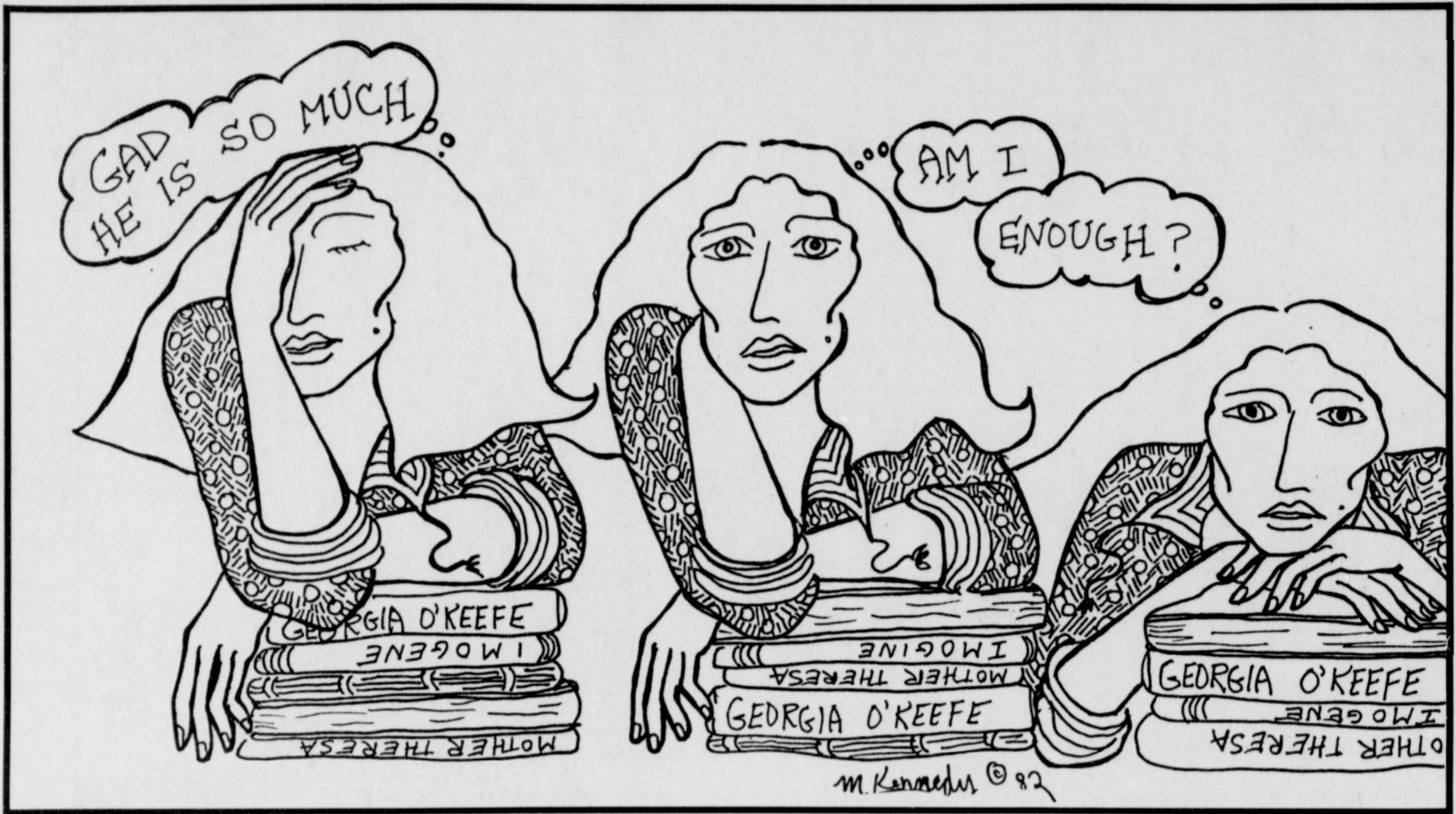

She got a job to pay for the sign, enrolled the children in a local school and began to draw a comic strip, "Mad Marion in

Peyton Port." The strip was originally a regular feature of the Gilmore Gazette, which was combined with the now defunct Bayfront Funnies. "Mad Marion" now also appears in the Lincoln Letters (formerly the Log), which circulates in Lincoln County, and in her father's newspaper, the Fullerton Observer in California.
