

AN UNDEVELOPED ARGUMENT

The attempt to sell these beverages will be met with swift retaliation. The distribution of any drugs not directly affecting the preservation of life must be disrupted. The flu, common colds, headaches, constipation, athlete's feet, and all other common maladies will be forced into continuance until we are allowed to legally use the substance of our choice.

Marijuana seed will be planted everywhere. No place shall be immune; schoolyards, police station gardens, courthouse squares, your own garden at home. It grows like a weed and it spreads like a weed.
