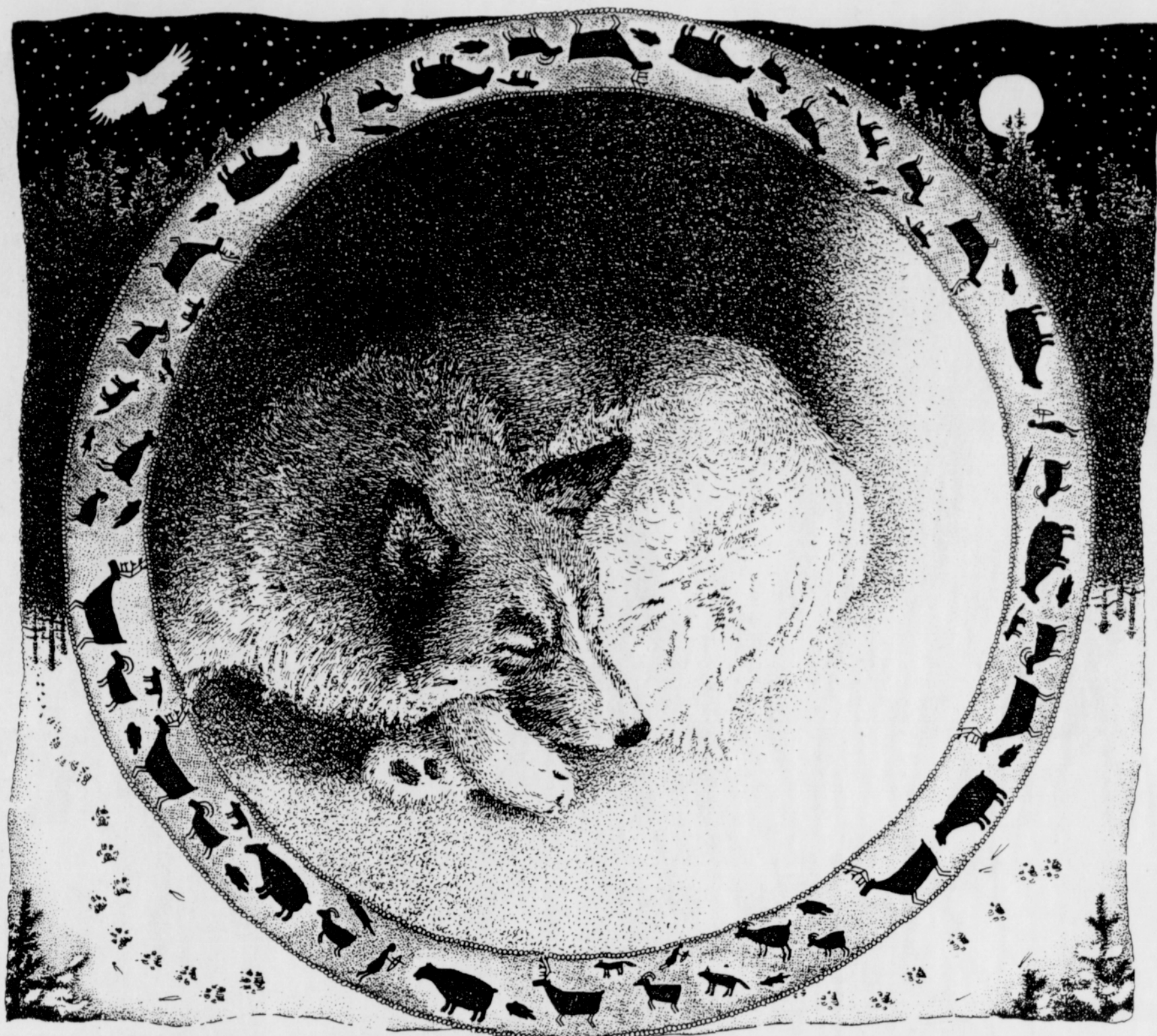




NORTHWEST MOONS
