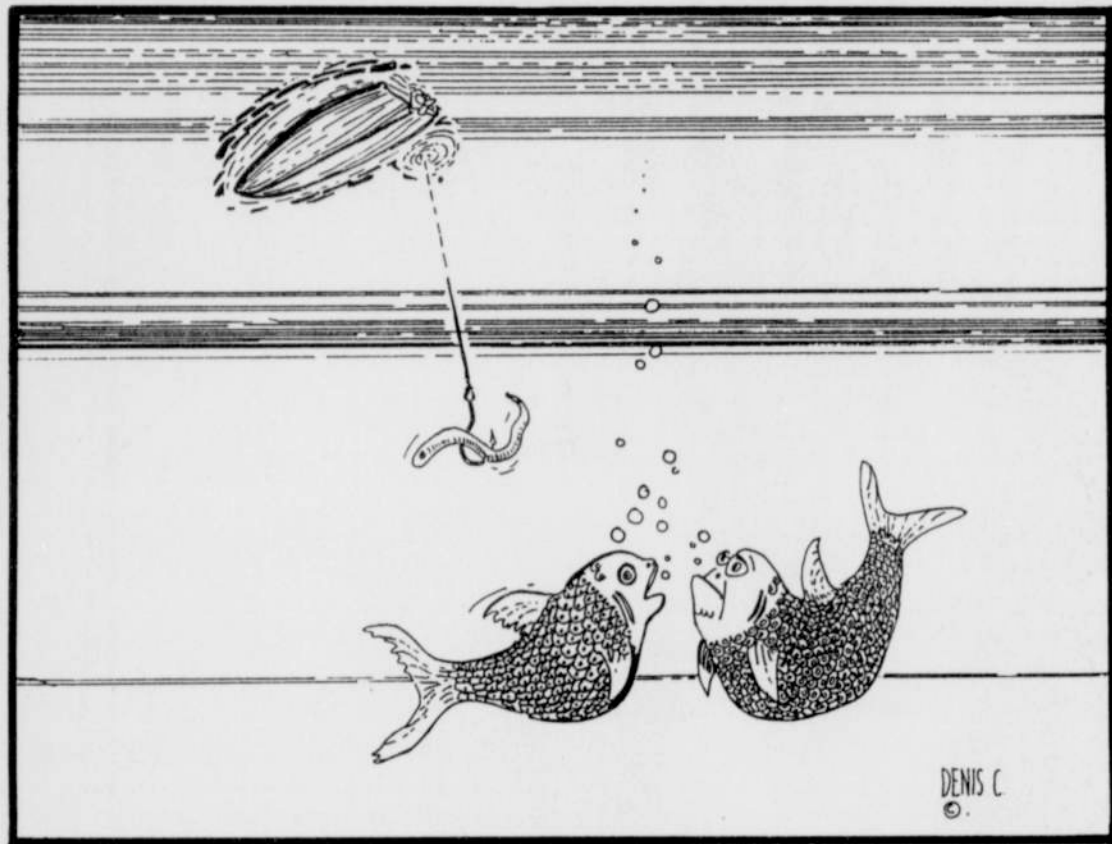

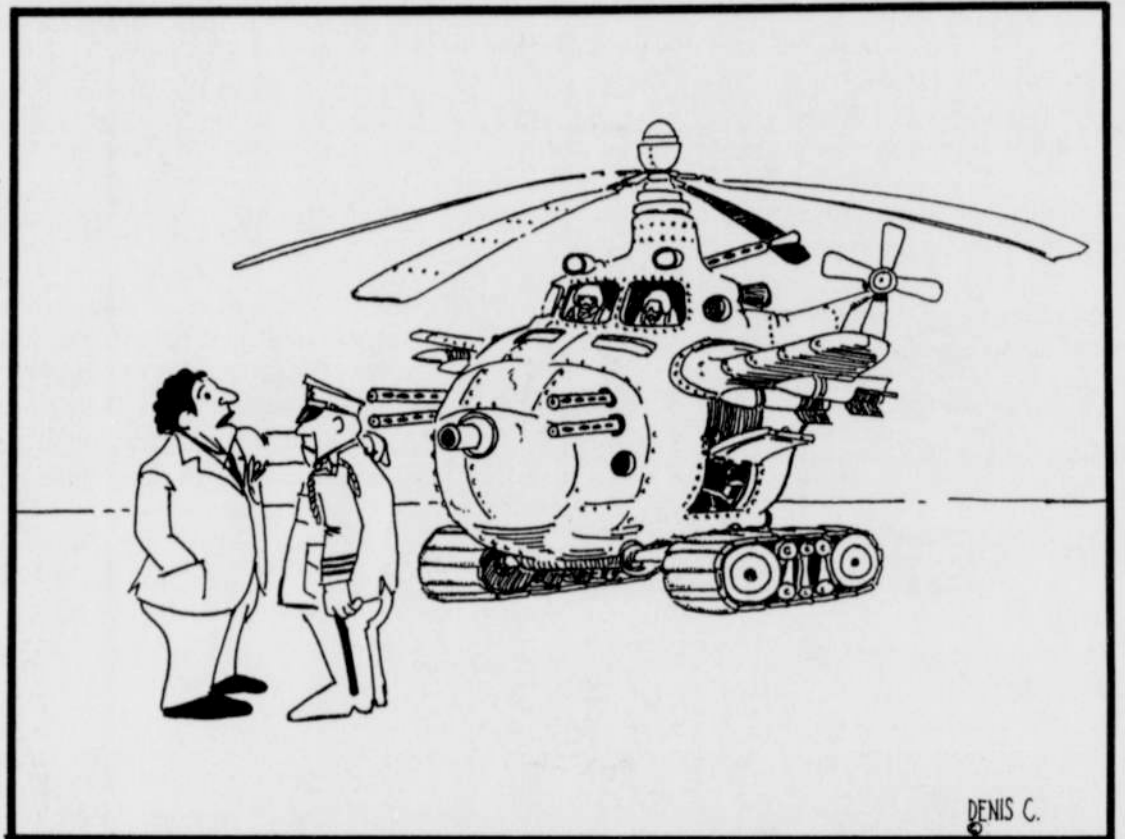
"Pardon me Miss but could you tell us where the Westchester County Chrysanthemum Society annual exhibit is located?"

He says of his cartoons:

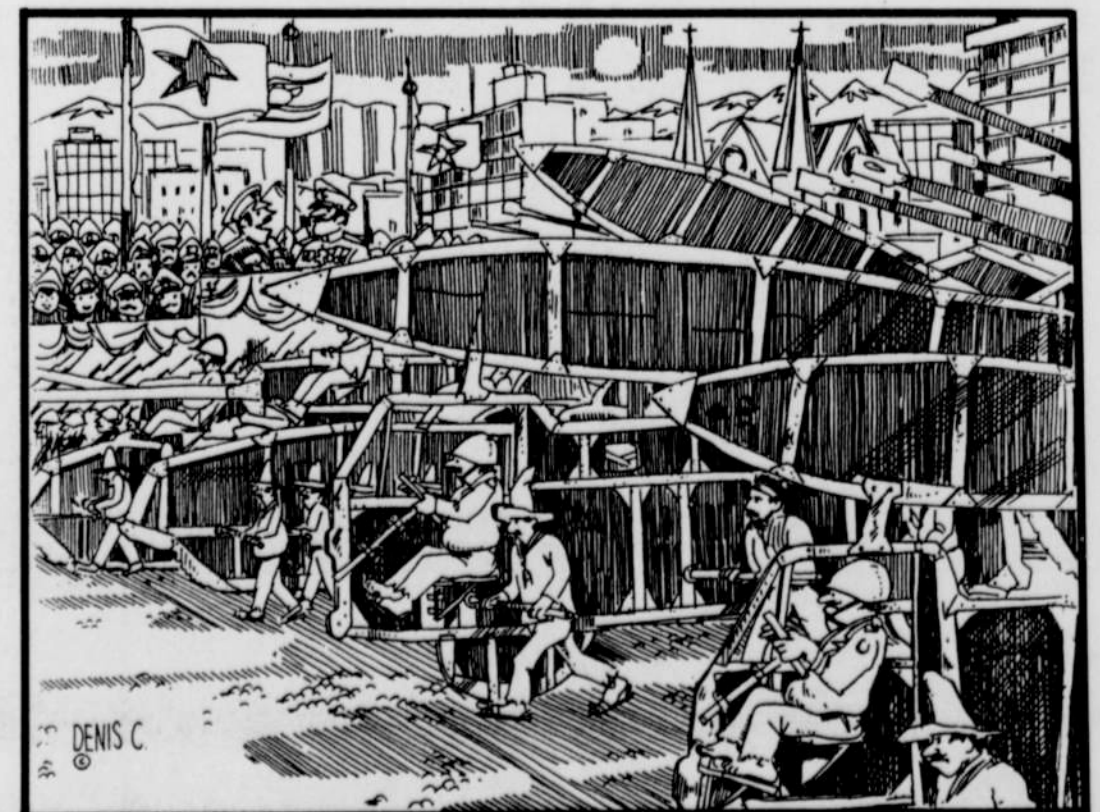
