Several weeks ago six VISTA Volunteers began working in Green Villa. They saw that there was an old restaurant in the camp not being used. After talking with many people in the camp they decided to go to work and "re-model" it.

About twenty residents of Green Villa came and together they are cleaning out the building and putting in school desks. They are painting the walls and cleaning off the shelves. Soon it will be ready.

The VISTA girls will be there during the day to take care of the young children. The adults will use it at night for classes.

Sometimes it will be used as a social center. Everyone will work to keep it nice and clean.
