REGISTER FOR VOTING at the Woodburn Opportunity Center on Friday afternoon and evening, April 22. Bring family and friends. It is important to register, and it is easy. REGISTER! — Ben Graham

In a democracy the voter holds the key to power. The politician, the President, the school board all listen to this power. If you vote, the elected official will listen to you. If you are not a voter, the official may listen, but he has no real reason to act.

Yes, you can have the power of a voter. All you have to do is register to vote. If you can read and write English in simple form — if you are a citizen — if you are a resident of Oregon (6 months) — the power of voting is waiting for you.

Elections are often won by a few votes one way or the other. Recently in Dallas a school election to construct a new building and make a better school program was defeated by 8 people.

To vote, register now. If you register before April 23, you will be able to use that power in May 24 — a primary election. The outcome may affect your life. Help build a better community by voting.

Ask your Opportunity Center how to register. Or ask at any bank. Someone will help you.
