

Maypole dance a credit to teenage clubs



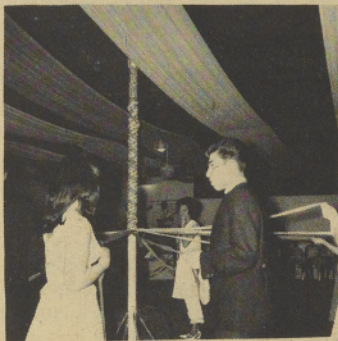
