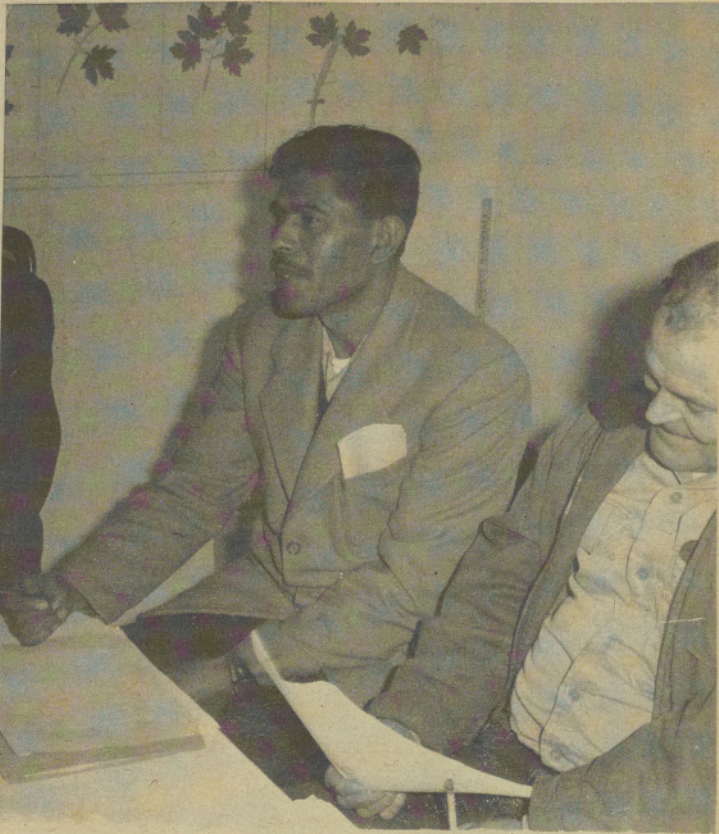
ere are few facilities available

educación.

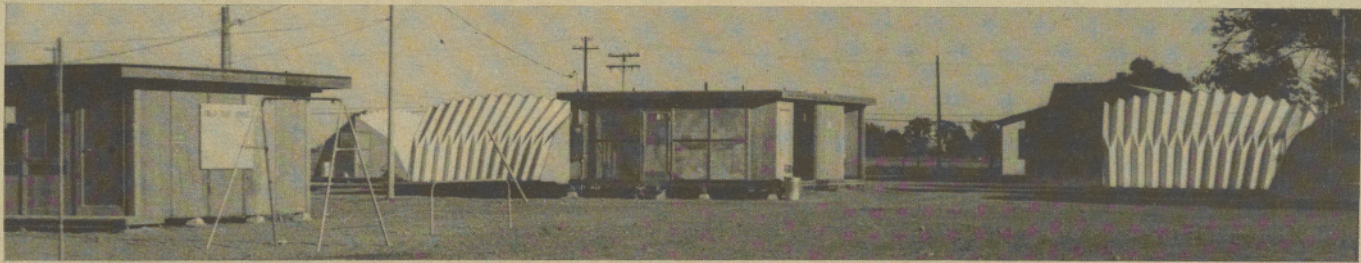
A los que piscan nuestras

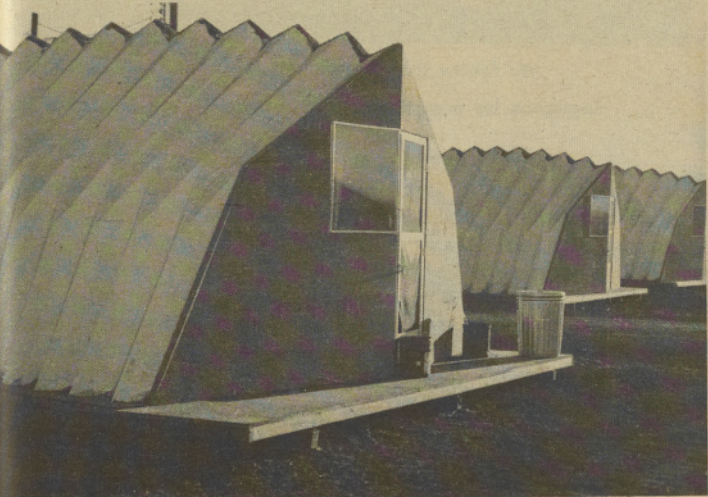

PLYDOME UNIT

The migrant families who live here are proud of their clean camp.
The camp administrator established rules of sanitation. The rules were en-

forced. Most migrant families prefer to be clean. They return each year
to a well kept camp.



The plydomes are comfortable in California weather. Each family
is supplied with beds, gas stove, and a sink with a cold water tap.



Madison Camp has four bath and toilet units. Each unit has eight
showers and eight toilets. These facilities are cleaned twice a day.
