



COBLEIGH BRIDGE, DEFIES DEMOLITION

Congratulations to the members of the recently formed Cobleigh Road Association for your successful efforts to designate the **Cobleigh Bridge, historically significant!**

Your efforts to save this beautiful bridge from demolition received the support of the Jackson Co. Historical Advisory Commission. The Commission recommended that county commissioners declare the Cobleigh Bridge, historically significant. This bridge, built in 1913, that has been part of many local residents' lives, is the oldest surviving automobile bridge in the county. It was a segment of a bridge that once crossed the Rogue River at TouVelle St. Park. It was moved to Cobleigh, over Butte Creek, in 1953.

This bridge is one of four in Jackson Co. that has been scheduled for replacement. Funding for this project will come from the federal government (80%) and the State of Oregon (10%) and Jackson Co. (10%). The projected cost is 1.26 million American tax dollars for a structure that only needs to be painted!
