→→→ ...PULL TO THE RIGHT

If you see or hear an ambulance, police car, fire truck, or emergency medical services vehicle while driving, the American College of Emergency Physicians offers the following tips:

- Pull as far to the right as possible, parallel to the curb or road edge and stop clear of any intersections until the vehicle passes or you are otherwise directed by police.
- Make sure your car stereo is not turned up too loud. If necessary, keep the driver side window cracked so audible signals can be heard.
- Most severe accidents involving police, fire, or EMS vehicles occur at intersections. Remember to be alert at all times.
- Use caution when reentering the traffic flow once the emergency vehicle has passed.

All states adhere to the practice of pulling to the right for emergency vehicles. In many states, it's the law.
