CITY HALL AND COUNCIL NEWS

City Council meetings are held the **second Thursday of each month** and are open to the public. Special sessions are held when necessary and may or may not be open to the public, it depends on the reason for the meeting. Executive sessions are not open to the public, however, no decision pertaining to Town business can be made in executive session; council must come into open session to make a decision. Employee policy and/or employee relation meetings are not open to the public unless the employee wishes to have it so. Budgetary work sessions are open to the public.

Planning Commission:

Meetings are held at **7:00 pm on Tuesday night**, the same week as council. In other words, two days prior to Council. These meetings are open to the public. The next meeting is **June 6th, at 7:00 pm at City Hall.**
