Fireworks Safety

We are in "fireworks season" again, and are in need of help. Because fires caused by fireworks are a continuing problem, we are asking that everyone please assist us in achieving our goal of **NO FIREWORKS-CAUSED FIRES** here in the Butte Falls area.

In the first nine months of 1994, there were 406 fireworks-caused fires in the State of Oregon, including one in Butte Falls.

Let's all work together to see that fireworks are not involved in causing fires and damage in our town!!!



Safety Tips

1. Use only **LEGAL** fireworks: those which produce only smoke, sparks or fire but don't explode, eject balls of fire, fly into the air or travel over 12 feet on smooth ground.
2. Have a *responsible* adult present.
3. Keep water or a fire extinguisher handy.
4. Use fireworks outdoors, away from dry grass, buildings and wooded areas.
5. Light one item at a time, move away quickly and keep a safe distance.

6. Never give fireworks to a small child.

7. Never throw fireworks at people or at vehicles.

8. **Have fun, but BE SAFE!!!!!!**
