Summer Office Hours

The High School and Elementary School soon will be on summer hours. You can reach them from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon. Then from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.

Athletic Physicals

Athletic physicals for any student participating in extra-curricular sports will be given on Wednesday, August 17th at Eagle Point Jr. High from 6:00pm to 8:30pm. Bus transportation will be provided by the school district. The bus will leave Butte Falls at 5:00pm. Cost of the physicals will be \$2.00. Any student who had a physi-

cal last year does not need to take one this year. Physical examinations are only required every other year. All other forms need to be done early.

Before you can practice...

Students must have four documents on file in the school offices prior to participating in any practice. 1. Participation permit must be filled out and signed by parent/guardian. 2. Medical release form must be filled out and signed by parent/guardian. 3. Insurance coverage can be through private policy or insurance can be purchased through the school. All students must have insurance coverage prior to participating in any practice. Cost of insurance through the school is approximately \$60.00. Jr. High students may turn in forms and payment to the elementary office at the beginning of school. 4. All forms will be available at the time of physicals or can be picked up at the high school or elementary school offices.
