Butte Falls Volunteer Ambulance

Be careful on those very hot days! Make sure you're drinking plenty of water, before you feel thirsty!

If you don't put those fluids into your body, you'll start going into shock. In a mild form it will resemble fainting. At this point you'll need to be moved to a cool, shady area, laying flat with legs elevated sipping cool, salty fluids (Gatorade is good too!). This will bring improvement in about 30 minutes. If you see someone in this type of condition, and they are not improving you will need to call an ambulance. If left too long heat exhaustion can lead to heat stroke. You'll see headache, dizziness, hot, usually dry and flushed skin and a rapid pulse (160 to 180 beats per minute). Someone with heat exhaustion on the other hand will present with pale, cool sweating skin.

In the very late stages of heat stroke you'll see convulsions, brain damage and death. Cool these patients with whatever means are available. Snow, ice, immersion in a lake or wrapped in wet blankets.

If you're unsure of someone's condition, you can always call one of your local EMT's!

FREE BLOOD PRESSURE CHECKS the **second Monday of each month** from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Come to the barn and have your BP checked and recorded.
