In this column, I will attempt to provide you with information about our Town Council meetings and other bits of information that may be of interest and not covered in other town reports.

Anne Tucker has provided "News from City Hall" for this issue. This has covered most of the August council meeting information. That meeting was my first, as mayor, and an interesting one. We had several members of the community present who were most upset. I could not miraculously solve the addressed concerns. However, I have personally investigated matters and can now more knowledgeably respond.

On Sunday, August 20th, I traveled the streets and alleys of Butte Falls with our Town Marshall, Bill Johnson. He showed me each of the locations whose residents had received violation notices to our Town Ordinance #1. Twenty-five persons received violation notices. On behalf of the Town Council, I thank each of you who have taken action or completed steps necessary to meet ordinance compliance. THANKS! We, as a town, have a few areas that we need to improve the appearance of also. We are working on these. Our Public Works/Maintenance person, Scott Mallory, has been without an assistant for many moons. One person can only do so much; the sewer and water system maintenance work is a full time job by itself. Hopefully, soon, we will have a public works assistant to help with some of the routine maintenance to the park and city property. Additionally, we may have some students interested in community service work.
