If you're interested in becoming a 1st Responder or EMT, please call Carrie Driskell at 865-3224. At this time we have one 1st Responder and four EMT's which isn't enough when you're trying to cover 24 hours a day for 365 days a year. Only one of the EMT's is in Butte Falls during the day, and sometimes that isn't even the case...which leaves the 1st Responder covering our service area until an EMT gets back into town. Another tough time to cover is weekends. We don't want to see burnout starting to enter our service up here---but we need to cover our area.
