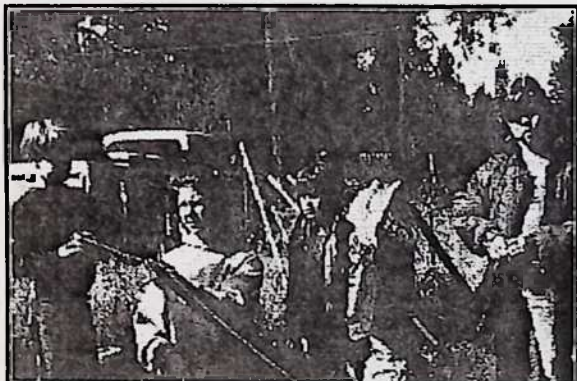




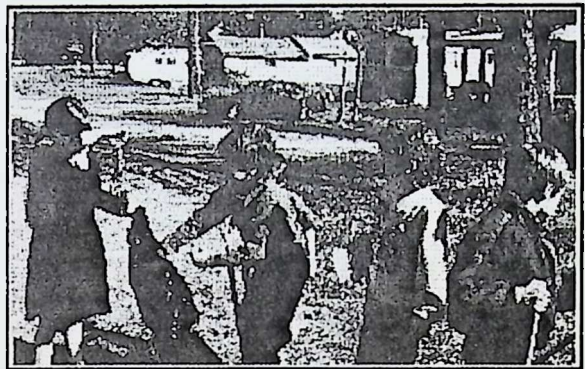
Clyde and Beth working in herb garden
