A meeting was held on Thursday, February 19, 1998 at the Administration Building of the Butte Falls High School. Citizens present were: John Adams, Mary Casey, Carla LeFever, Anne Tucker, Dick and Wendy Earl, Harvey Boyle, Joyce Hailicka, Ken Owens and Moderator, Dianne Gorman.

The Technology Center would benefit both the Schools and the General Public by providing a place where adults and students alike could use the computers and access the internet.

THE PLAN: A large area in the school's administration office is being targeted for the use of the Technology Center. Grants will be needed to obtain the needed money to develop the system. It will also be necessary to have continuing funds available to keep the Center going. Students will be part time instructors for persons who need help. Fees will be charged for the usages and classes. It was also determined that a full time person would be needed to be able to keep the Center open the number of hours planned.
