Small children use the "Little Tucker"

playground, and should not be subjected to playing in or stepping in or falling in doggy do-do. The Marshal will begin ticketing dogs owners for not complying with the Towns leash law ordinance. Please avoid getting a citation, keep your dogs in your yard.

Now is the time to be sure the Town fences are all in place. Range cattle will once again be roaming the hills around town. There have already been cattle spotted in the Red Hill area that should not be there yet. If any cattleguard gate or fence around town is down, contact me at Public Works so I can get them repaired. If anybody has taken down a Town perimeter fence for any reason, be sure it gets repaired as soon as possible.

UPPER ROGUE VAN TO CHANGE OPERATIONS

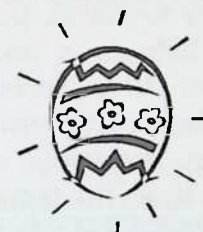
