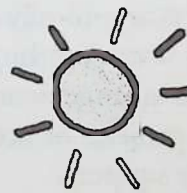
-Recipe of the Month-

Easy Beef and Noodles

- ½ pound sirloin steak, cut into strips
- 1 medium onion, sliced
- 1 can mushrooms, drained
- 2 tablespoons oil
- 2 packages beef-flavored ramen noodles
- 4 1/4 cups water, divided

Saute steak, onion, mushrooms in oil. Set noodle seasoning packets aside. Bring 4 cups water to a boil. Add noodles, cook until tender. Drain. Add noodles, seasoning and remaining water to skillet with meat mixture: Heat through.
