

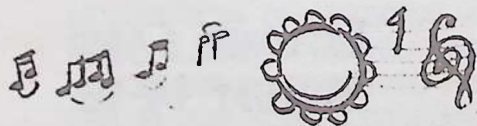
# SCHOOL NEWS!

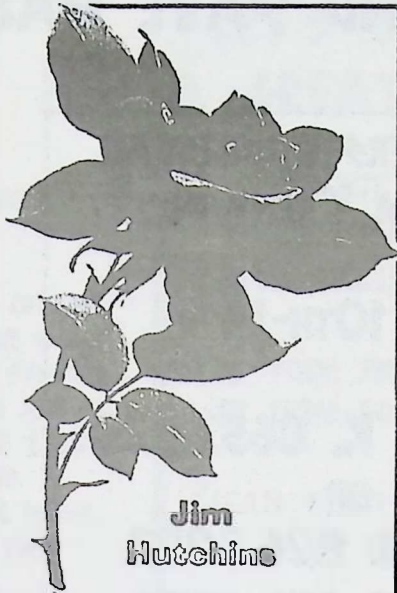

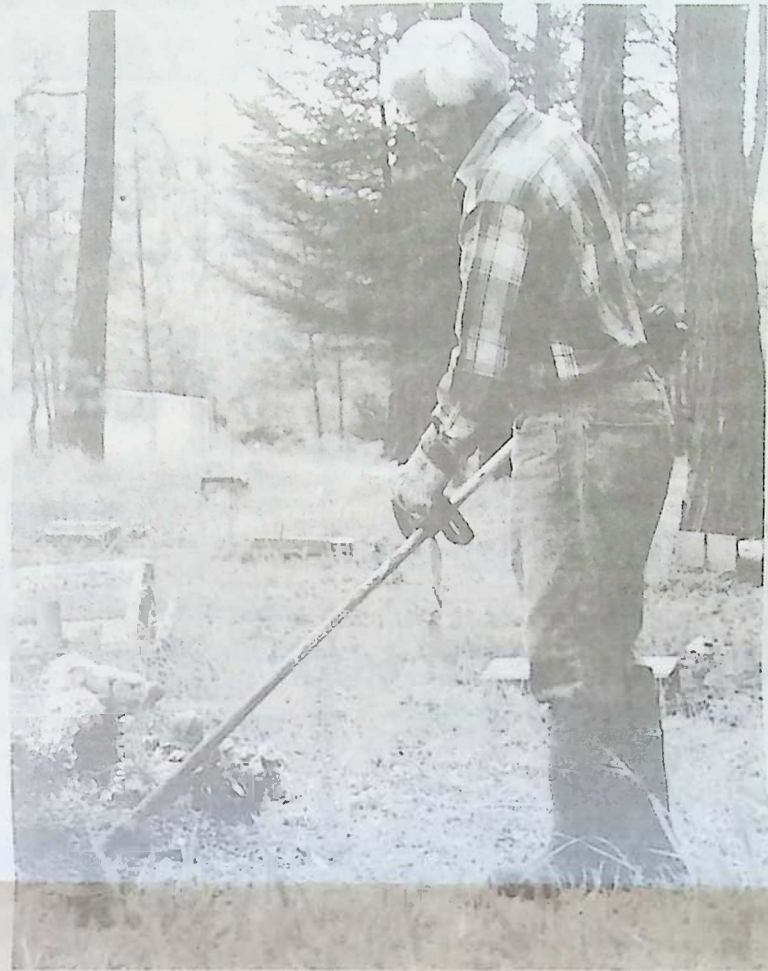
