- 5/1 5/15 5/29 6/12 6/26

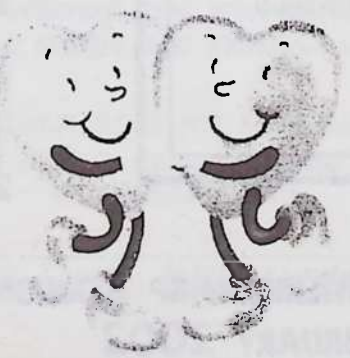
