Summer Outdoor Activities for Kid's- July's Schedule

SATURDAY, JULY 7, 2001 "BARKING UP THE RIGHT TREE"

We live in a timber community. Everyday we look at trees. But, have you ever stopped to notice the intricate patterns and textures of tree bark. Children will use drawing paper and crayons and do gentle rubbings and construct a local tree identification book.

Ages 8 and Up

SATURDAY, JULY 14, 2001 "HONEY, I BLEW UP THE GRASSHOPPER"

Using a magnifying glass, youngsters will learn to see things in nature magnified many times. Observe rings on a worm, the antennae of an insect, the veins in a leaf, the surface of rock. Children will draw a blown up version of a plant, insect, or object.

SATURDAY, JULY 21, 2001 "BUDDING SCIENTIST"

Children will observe many kinds of plants growing in the garden and surrounding yard at the museum. With a notebook and pencil in hand children will design a plant journal that notes characteristics of particular plants, sketches of plants, and other important details. Is it a vegetable, a flower, a shrub. Is it edible? Does it have other uses?

Ages 10-14

SATURDAY, JULY 28, 2001 "GROW A BUTTERFLY"

Watch a magical transformation of a caterpillar into a butterfly. Children will take a walking trip to collect stems of milkweed, a plant that grows three feet in height. Collect stalks with a monarch butterfly caterpillar attached. Children will place stalks in a jar of water to keep them alive. Caterpillars will munch the leaves. Toward the end of August, caterpillar will form a chrysalis. About two weeks later, a monarch butterfly will magically appear.

Ages 5 and Up
