So, bring your families to our Quaint Country Setting and enjoy the glorious day. Come celebrate our Veterans. Because if not for them, we would not have this life to celebrate.

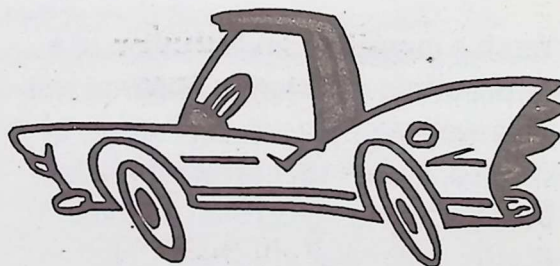
