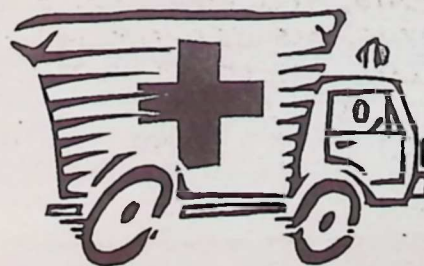
### From your Mercy Flights Ambulance Crew- by Carrie Driskell
