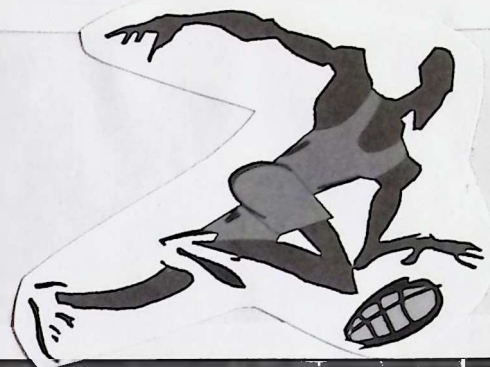
I wonder if the people who claim flag burning is free speech are the same people who would like to force Rush Limbaugh off the radio for being too pro-American? Probably so.

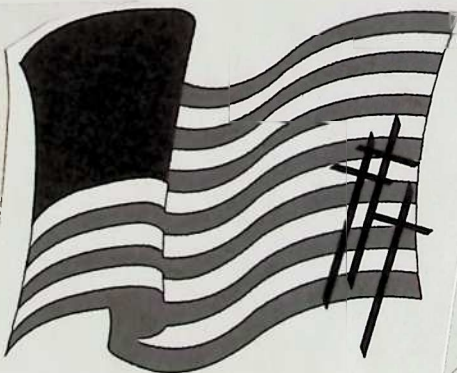
Our community should be very proud of each one of them for all their hard work they put out this season. This will be the first time in 10 years we have been represented by both teams.
