

To: Citizens of Butte Falls

The Mayor's office and Town Council have been getting complaints from citizens stating that vehicles are being stored (parked) within illegal, portable parking structures on or partially on city property, such as city streets. We are also getting complaints of vehicles that do not run and appear to be abandoned on city property by homeowners. This notice is to explain, once again as this article already appeared in the June 2002 issue, the legalities of parking or abandoning vehicles on city property. Ordinance #1.1a allows the parking of vehicles along city streets as long as they are properly licensed and are in running condition. Ordinance #203 does not restrict parking along city streets, however, it does restrict the use of accessory structures on or encroaching on city streets or other city property.

Section 4.030 - General Provisions Regarding Accessory Uses and Structures. 1. An accessory use shall comply with the requirements for a principal use except as this ordinance specifically allows to the contrary. 2. An accessory structure, if only one story, may be located as follows: a) side yard setback: 5 feet from over hang. b) rear yard setback: 5 feet. c) if on an alley: 3 feet setback. 3. Any structure over 120 square feet requires a building permit.

Section 4.040 - Site Design Procedure: It is the purpose of this section to provide for the review of site plans (plot plans) of proposed projects under consideration of the Town. 1) All projects for single family residence and manufactured homes on individual lots, shall be required to obtain site design approval. 2) the Town Planning Commission is the body that reviews and makes recommendations to the Town Council of all applicable site designs. Contact the Planning Commission for all requirements for an application and for the standards for approval. They meet the first Tuesday of every month at City Hall at 7:00 PM.

Please contact Doug Ownby, Public Works Maintenance Officer, if you already have plans to have on of these structures near your residence. We are concerned that these structures are not

only on city property, but are located over city water and sewer lines. **IF YOU HAVE ONE OF THESE STRUCTURES ALREADY IN PLACE, YOU HAVE 15 DAYS TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE.** In regards to the vehicle problems around Town, our police department will start enforcing the Ordinance which pertains to your area. You will receive a warning to remove your vehicle within so many days. If this is not done in the required time frame, our police department will start issuing fines until the matter is taken care of.

We want to start having a little more pride in our community and clean it up, so your immediate attention to these matters is greatly appreciated. Mayor Steve Harvey and the Town Council.

Look for number inside recycle triangle on container. Examples: Shampoo, liquid soap, deodorant, hand lotion, seasoning containers, salad dressing, juice, old tupperware, salsa, margarine, yogurt, cottage cheese, plastic bags, old toys, blister packs (paper removed), and of course Milk Jugs and Water / Soda bottles, and don't forget all those plastic lids. **WASH, RINSE and DRAIN DRY** either in the dishwasher or hot water. Place in plastic bags. Mix all colored and numbered plastics together.

PLEASE NO TRASH OR CONTAMINATED MATERIALS. THIS PILOT PROJECT WILL HELP DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF MATERIALS THAT CAN BE SAVED FROM THE LANDFILL. THE PLASTIC RECYCLER IS ATTEMPTING TO CREATE AN EASIER PROCESS METHOD AT EVERY LEVEL.....
