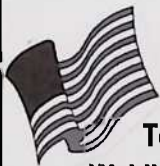


## It's Time To Clean Up This Town! ( Got your attention, huh?)

Southern Oregon Sanitation has purchased a new garbage truck and would like to offer curb side recycling service, hopefully starting in July or August. When this takes effect, the service day will change from the current Monday to Friday. If you want the blue curb side recycle box, you will need to sign up for the service. The new service rate will be \$13.05 for a 35 gallon can and \$22.00 for a 65 gallon can. The cost of the curb side recycling service is included in the new rate. The Town Council supports this new service and will pick a day when you can sign up for it and receive your blue recycle box. More details will be in the next month's newsletter.
