The town council at their regular council meeting on September 19<sup>th</sup> discussed the possibility of making changes to the Late notices portion of the Water and Sewer billing policy. They decided to keep the policy as is, meaning if you are 30 days behind on your bill you will receive a late notice with your bill, giving you 10-days to pay. If you have not paid on the 10<sup>th</sup> day by 1:00p.m., you will receive a second notice posted on your door at your home giving you until 9:00 am the next morning. If no payment has been made your service will be disconnected. There will be no exceptions if you call the City Recorder or Mayor asking for an extension. The council feels that the first two weeks of the month is a sufficient amount of time to get caught up on your "past due amount", leaving the last two weeks of the month to pay your current portion of the bill.

### Depot News!

As you may have heard, the council on a four (4) to two (2) vote, voted to sell the library "Depot" to the Jackson County Library System. This has been a long process in the making and a very difficult decision on all Council member's part. I want to thank the Council and the Mayor for "sticking it out" and to know that the Town Treasurer Sue Macy and I have always been behind you, no matter what the decision.
